## About Barcelona



Barcelona is arguably the most beautiful city of Spain, well known for its dramatic architecture, gothic quarter, parks and museums, world class dining, entertainment and shopping. Barcelona is Located in a privileged position on the northeastern coast of the Iberian Peninsula and the shores of the Mediterranean. The capital of the province of Catalonia, it is unequivocally a Mediterranean city, not only because of its geographic location but also because of its history,

tradition, and cultural influences. The documented history of the city dates back to the founding of a Roman colony on its soil during the second century B.C. Modern The city's Gothic Quarter bears witness to the splendor enjoyed by the city from the 13th to the 15th centuries. The 20th century ushered in widespread urban renewal throughout Barcelona, culminating in its landmark Eixample district, which showcases some of Barcelona's most distinctive Catalán art nouveau, or modernista, buildings. Antoni Gaudí, one of the most eminent architects, designed buildings such as the Casa Milà, the Casa Batlló and the Sagrada Família church, which have become world-famous landmarks.

### **About GIRONA & FIGUERES with Dalí Museum – Full Day Tour**

## About Madrid, the capital of Spain



The capital of Spain, located in the heart of the peninsula and right in the center of the Castilian plain 646 meters above sea level, has a population of over three million. A cosmopolitan city, a business center, headquarters for the Public Administration, Government, Spanish Parliament and the home of the Spanish Royal Family, Madrid also plays a major role in both the banking and industrial sectors. Most of its industry is located in the Southern fringe of the city, where important textile, food and metal working factories are clustered. Madrid is characterized by intense cultural and artistic activity and a very lively nightlife. The grand metropolis of Madrid can trace its origins to the times of Arab Emir Mohamed I (852-886), who ordered the construction of a fortress on the left bank of the Manzanares river. Later it became the subject of a dispute between the Christians and Arabs until it was conquered by Alonso VI in the 11th

century. At the end of the 17th century, a defensive wall was built for the protection of the new outlying areas, tracing the roads of Segovia, Toledo and Valencia. During the 18th century, under the reign of Carlos III, were designed the great arteries of the city, such as the Paseo del Prado and Paseo las Acacias.

At the beginning of the 19th century, Joseph Bonaparte undertook the reform of the Puerta del Sol and vicinity. The commercial street known as the Gran Vía was built as an east-west avenue at the start of the century. In the 1950's the north-south boulevard called Paseo de la Castellana was extended and modern buildings were erected, housing the major financial institutions. Remainings of the distant past are mainly the Baroque and neoclassical structures of the 17th and 18th centuries, such as the Plaza Mayor (Main Square), the Palacio Real (Royal Palace) and others which will be described later during our guide of the city.

## **ITINERARY BARCELONA, MADRID & SEVILLE**

### **Day 1 USA – Barcelona, Spain**

Evening departure on your transatlantic flight to Europe. Dinner, movie, and breakfast on board.

### **Day 2 – Arrival in Barcelona – Afternoon City Tour**

Morning arrival in Barcelona. Meeting and assistance upon arrival at the airport and transfer to your centrally located hotel. This afternoon we'll take you to enjoy an escorted tour of one of Europe's most beautiful cities. See the ancient Gothic Quarter with its magnificent cathedral. Stop to admire the exterior of Gaudi's masterwork, the Basilica of the Sacred Family (Sagrada Familia). Continue to Montjuich Hill (site of the Olympic Stadium), to enjoy a spectacular view of Barcelona and its port area. In the evening, we will offer you a Welcome Dinner typical at restaurant FONT DE PRADES in Pueblo Español, featuring architectural replicas from all of Spain's regions. Overnight in Barcelona.

### **Day 3 – Barcelona - Girona, Figueres & Dali Museum**



**Buffet breakfast.** Day trip that takes you to two major towns in northern Catalonia: Figueres, with its landmark Theatre-Museum Dalí, and Girona, a monumental and ancient city, which is home to one of Europe’s best-preserved Jewish quarters. Guided walking tour of Girona and visit to the Dali Museum and “Dalí jokes” in Figueres with admission fee also included as well as a whole host of discounts. **Dinner with wine at restaurant LA TABERNA GALLEGA in the Olympic Port.** Overnight in Barcelona.

### **Day 4: Barcelona at Leisure**

Discover this magnificent town on your own and admire its rich architecture shown all over the buildings of the city center, stroll along the “Ramblas boulevard”, or take an optional tout to the Monserrat Basilica. Come evening, we will take you to **Dinner with at a typical Catalanian restaurant.** Overnight in Barcelona.

### **Day 5 - Barcelona-Madrid**

After **breakfast** at your hotel in Barcelona, you’ll be taken to the Train Station to board THE AVE HIGH-SPEED TRAIN to Madrid. Welcome and transfer to your centrally located hotel. In the early evening, enjoy an “Illuminated Madrid” drive through the bustling streets of the old city, ending at the historical and impressive Plaza Mayor. This area is home to some of the most typical restaurants and taverns, which serve the delicious "tapas". Tonight, **a welcome TAPAS Dinner wine is included at typical restaurant LA TAURINA.** Return to your hotel on your own this evening. Overnight in Madrid.

## Day 6 Madrid City Tour

**Buffet breakfast.** This morning's escorted sightseeing tour will allow you to get a glimpse of some of Madrid's most outstanding attractions, like the Puerta del Sol, the magnificent fountains of Neptune and Cibeles, the stately Alcala Gate, the busy Gran Via, the Plaza de España and the Plaza de Oriente. Highly recommended this afternoon, is an optional tour to the Imperial former capital city of Toledo, where you will be escorted through its narrow cobblestone streets, soaking up the medieval atmosphere. Touring will include the interior of the magnificent Gothic cathedral and a visit to St. Tome Church, where El Greco's masterpiece painting is displayed. There will also be some time for shopping for the unique typical local artisans. **Dinner with wine in a local restaurant.** Overnight in Madrid.

## Day 7: Madrid – Tour to Toledo & El Escorial

Buffet breakfast and departure for you full day sightseeing tour of the Imperial former capital city of Toledo and the Palace of El Escorial. In Toledo you will be escorted through its narrow cobblestone streets, soaking up the medieval atmosphere. Touring will include the interior of the magnificent Gothic cathedral and a visit to St. Tome Church, where El Greco's masterpiece painting is displayed. There will also be some time for shopping for the unique typical local artisans. In the afternoon we head to the town of El Escorial to admire its outstanding Palace . Once just a sleepy little resort town northwest of Madrid, San Lorenzo de El Escorial now hosts thousands of tourists coming in throngs to see the famous royal monastery. In addition to being home to an order of monks, this attraction also acts as a royal palace, museum and school.

Commissioned by King Felipe II as a testament to Spain's devout Catholic faith, El Escorial was built in the 16th century after defeating the French in the Battle of Saint Quentin (with help from the heavens). The highlights of the immense complex include the elegant basilica, the marble Pantheon de los Reyes, where many kings and their relatives are buried, and the Patio de los Reyes.

Tonight we will offer you a **Dinner with wine in a typical restaurant in downtown Madrid.** Overnight in Madrid

### **Day 8 Madrid-Seville by AVE High-Speed Train**

**Buffet breakfast.** Today we'll take you to Madrid train station to board the AVE HIGH-SPEED TRAIN TO SEVILLE. Arrival and transfer to your centrally located Hotel. Rest of day at leisure. **Dinner with wine at a local Andalusian restaurant.** Overnight in Seville.

### **Day 9 Seville City Tour & Flamenco**

**Buffet breakfast.** This morning's tour will explore this gracious and charming city, Spain's third largest. See the Tower of Gold, the tranquil and extensive Maria Luisa Park, the quaint Santa Cruz Quarter, and finally the huge cathedral (one of the world's largest) with its Giralda Tower (a former minaret). Time for lunch on your own. The afternoon is free to continue to explore or shop.

**Farewell Dinner with wine at restaurant ABADES TRIANA , facing the river and the Golden Tower.** This evening, after dinner, we'll take you to **a Flamenco Show at Palacio Andaluz** including a drink. Overnight in Seville.

**Day 10 Seville - USA:** Breakfast and departure transfer from your hotel to the Airport for your transatlantic flight home, arriving later today.
